



Owen-a-Doodle's Health Guarantee

All of our puppies are guaranteed to be in good health and free from visible signs of infection and contagious or communicable diseases when purchased.

Within 7 days of Purchase

The buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within **three (3) business days** of taking possession, activate a minimum of the 30 free days of **Trupanion Health insurance**, and activate the registration of the **Home Again** microchip. If your puppy is returned to us for any reason other than an accident within 7 days of purchase we will take the puppy back and refund 100% of the purchase price.

- A. If the puppy is found to be in poor health, the Buyer has the option of returning the puppy to the Seller, at the Buyer's cost, for a full refund. _____
- B. The Buyer will provide a written statement from a licensed veterinarian clearly stating the defect or illness. _____
- C. If the puppy is not taken to a licensed veterinarian within seven business days of taking possession, the health guarantee is void. _____
- D. Please ensure that the puppy is kept in a kennel or held in the waiting room of a veterinary office, and that the exam room is properly disinfected before the appointment. _____
- E. Do not let the puppy walk on the floor in the veterinary office and ensure the room was cleaned prior to putting your puppy on the table. I recommend bringing a clean towel or blanket with you to be safe. _____

Lifetime Genetic Health Guarantee

If your puppy is diagnosed by a suitably qualified veterinarian as having a life threatening or seriously disabling defect of certain congenital/genetic origin in its lifetime this is our Lifetime Health Guarantee.

The most common genetic diseases in **Goldendoodles** are;

- [Hip dysplasia](#): common in large breed dogs but is still covered under our guarantee in severe instances or (Grade 3) cases, given that: your dog is never overweight, and has **not** been spayed or neutered before 12 months of age. _____
*Please refer to the Puppy Manual for advice on helping your puppy grow healthy hips and elbows.
- [Retinal dysplasia](#): can be detected at 3-4 weeks, but a veterinarian will be best able to examine the pup's eyes for this condition with an ophthalmoscope at 12 to 16 weeks of age, when the retina is mature and is covered by our guarantee up to the purchase price. _____
- [Subaortic stenosis](#): is covered if death occurs. _____

- **Elbow dysplasia - OCD of the elbow**: is covered by our guarantee in severe instances or (Grade 3) cases, given that: your dog is never overweight, and has **not** been spayed or neutered before 12 months of age. _____
*Please refer to the Puppy Manual for advice on helping your puppy grow healthy hips and elbows.
- **Gastric dilatation-volvulus**: can be caused by overeating, rapid eating, single daily feedings, high water consumption, stress, and exercise after eating. If your dog is to pass away from this condition and it was determined by a licensed veterinarian that none of these were the cause, it is covered by our guarantee. _____
- **sebaceous adenitis** : is a non life threatening disorder and if diagnosed, treatment is covered up to the purchase price of the dog. _____

***This warranty is void in the event of an undetermined or inconclusive diagnosis. Diseases of likely environmental origin (likely to be caused by suboptimal diet, chemicals, vaccination side effects, or trauma) are not covered. VIS pamphlets or Vaccination Information Statement pamphlets should be asked for and read by the puppy's owner before any administration of any vaccine is given; to best understand the benefits and the side effects that vaccines can cause. Any illness, disease or side effects associated with any vaccines if you do choose to administer them are then not of congenital/genetic origin and are not covered under Owen-a-Doodle's Health Guarantee. _____

If your puppy dies and you request a refund, you must have a necropsy performed by a suitably qualified veterinarian at your expense to determine the cause of death. Your puppy will be refunded if the death was caused by a genetic problem or an illness which your puppy had at the time of purchase. For this reason, I advise you to have your puppy checked by your own veterinarian within **72 hours** of purchase.

1. Buyer must supply any requested veterinary records as pertains to the dog's condition to the seller within seven days of diagnosis. _____
2. We reserve the right to require a second opinion from a veterinarian of our choice at our expense. _____
3. If necropsy is performed and results are undetermined or there's an inconclusive diagnosis, warranty is void. _____
4. If a life threatening congenital defect is identified, the Buyer has the option to choose from **ONE** of the following:

*Obtain a replacement puppy from the Seller of equal or lesser value from the next available litter.

*Receive a refund of 100% of the original purchase price.

*Receive payment for treatment, up to the original purchase price of the puppy, at a Veterinary clinic approved by us. Sign: _____.

****Breeder determines which puppy is a good fit and will be used as a replacement and the wait may be as long as 6-18 months, Color or gender is not guaranteed, and additional shipping fees will not be refunded, and any costs associated with the shipping for a replacement puppy are to be covered by Buyer._____

5. If the puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of, without a second opinion from the seller's veterinarian, the buyer waives all rights to a refund._____
6. This warranty does not include any non-congenital/genetic origin illnesses such as, infections, improper bites, stress-related illness, hernias, hypoglycemia, parasites (including Giardia or Coccidiosis), cancer or endocrine disorders. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals or physical injury._____
7. No warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied, are made under this contract except as stated._____
8. This Health Guarantee is non-transferable._____

***For the long-term health of your puppy we recommend a diet containing at least 20% **raw** meaty bones, minimal exposure to food additives. We also recommend minimizing exposure to veterinary drugs (such as flea and heart worm treatments, vaccinations and wormers) to the minimum dosage **and** frequency needed to safeguard the health of your pet_____

Spay and Neuter Contract:

1. Spaying/neutering by a licensed, reputable veterinarian is required on your puppy no sooner than 12 months but before 14 months of age.
 - A. Proof of this, in the form of a Certificate of Spay/Neuter from the Veterinarian, must be forwarded to the Seller by the time the puppy reaches 15 months of age.
 - B. If the Seller does not receive this documentation within this time, the Health Guarantee will become null and void.
2. It is understood that at the time of sale that the puppy is **not** to be used for breeding. It is a representation of its breed and it is structurally and temperamentally suited for a companion and / or working dog. It is being sold as a pet **without** breeding rights.

Lifetime Rehoming Guarantee

Your puppy also has a lifetime rehoming guarantee with us, so should you have an inability to care for him or her in the future, the buyer agrees to contact the Seller immediately if the buyer determines they are unable to keep their puppy for any reason and at **any stage** of your puppy's life. The Buyer also agrees that under no circumstances will they ever place their puppy within a rescue group, a shelter, a pound, or into any other similar facility or research laboratory.
