2. Purchase Agreement

The Buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within three (3) business days of taking possession, activate a minimum of the “30 free days” of Trupanion Health insurance, and activate the registration of the FI microchip. If your puppy is returned to us for any reason other than an accident within 7 days of purchase Breeder will take the puppy back and refund 100% of the purchase price minus the initial deposit of \$500 to cover any re-examination by our licensed veterinarian.

- 2.1 If the puppy is found to be in poor health within the first three days, the Buyer has the option of returning the puppy to the Breeder, at the Buyer's cost, for a full refund.
- 2.2 The Buyer will provide a written statement from a licensed veterinarian clearly stating the defect or illness.
- 2.3 If the puppy is not taken to a licensed veterinarian within seven business days of taking possession, the health guarantee is void.
- 2.4 Please ensure that the puppy is kept in a kennel or held in the waiting room of a veterinary office and that the exam room is properly disinfected before the appointment.
- 2.5 Do not let the puppy walk on the floor in the veterinary office and ensure the room was cleaned prior to putting your puppy on the table. I recommend bringing a clean towel or blanket with you to be safe.

3. Lifetime Genetic Health Guarantee

If your puppy is diagnosed by a suitably qualified veterinarian as having a life threatening or seriously disabling defect of certain congenital/genetic origin in its lifetime this is our Lifetime Genetic Health Guarantee. The most common genetic diseases in Goldendoodles are as follows:

- [Hip Dysplasia](#): common in large breed dogs but is still covered under our guarantee in severe instances or (Grade 3) cases, given that: your dog is never overweight, and has not been spayed or neutered before 12 months of age. Please refer to the Puppy Manual for advice on helping your puppy grow healthy hips and elbows.
- [Retinal Dysplasia](#): can be detected at 3-4 weeks, but a veterinarian will be best able to examine the pup's eyes for this condition with an ophthalmoscope at 12 to 16 weeks of age, when the retina is mature and is covered by our guarantee up to the purchase price.
- [Subaortic Stenosis](#): is covered if death occurs.
- [Elbow Dysplasia - OCD of the Elbow](#): is covered by our guarantee in severe instances or

(Grade 3) cases, given that: your dog is never overweight, and has not been spayed or neutered before 12 months of age. Please refer to the Puppy Manual for advice on helping your puppy grow healthy hips and elbows.

- [Gastric Dilatation-Volvulus](#): can be caused by overeating, rapid eating, single daily feedings, high water consumption, stress, and exercise after eating. If your dog is to pass away from this condition and it was determined by a licensed veterinarian that none of these were the cause, it is covered by our guarantee.
- [Sebaceous Adenitis](#): is a non life threatening disorder and if diagnosed, treatment is covered up to the purchase price of the dog.

This warranty is void in the event of an undetermined or inconclusive diagnosis. Diseases of likely environmental origin (likely to be caused by suboptimal diet, chemicals, vaccination side effects, or trauma) are not covered. VIS pamphlets or Vaccination Information Statement pamphlets should be asked for and read by the puppy's owner before any administration of any vaccine is given; to best understand the benefits and the side effects that vaccines can cause. Any illness, disease or side effects associated with [any vaccines if you do choose to administer them](#) are then not of congenital/genetic origin and are not covered under Breeder's Health Guarantee.

If your puppy dies and you request a refund, you must have a necropsy performed by a suitably qualified veterinarian at your expense to determine the cause of death. Your puppy will be refunded if the death was caused by a genetic problem or an illness which your puppy had at the time of purchase. *For this reason, I advise you to have your puppy checked by your own veterinarian within 72 hours of purchase.*

- 3.1 Buyer must supply any requested veterinary records as pertains to the dog's condition to the Breeder within seven days of diagnosis.
- 3.2 Breeder reserves the right to require a second opinion from a veterinarian of our choice at our expense.
- 3.3 If necropsy is performed and results are undetermined or there's an inconclusive diagnosis, warranty is void.
- 3.4 If a life threatening congenital defect is identified, the Buyer has the option to choose from ONE of the following:
 - Obtain a replacement puppy from the Breeder of equal or lesser value from the next available litter.
 - Breeder determines which puppy is a good fit and will be used as a replacement and the wait may be as long as 6-18 months, Color or gender is not guaranteed, and additional shipping fees will not be refunded, and any costs associated with the shipping for a replacement puppy are to be covered by Buyer.
 - Receive a refund of 100% of the original purchase price.
 - Receive payment for treatment, up to the original purchase price of the puppy, at a Veterinary clinic approved by us.
- 3.5 If the puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of, without a second opinion from the Breeder's veterinarian, the Buyer waives all rights to a refund.
- 3.6 This warranty does not include any non-congenital/genetic origin illnesses such as, infections, improper bites, stress-related illness, hernias, hypoglycemia, parasites (including Giardia or Coccidiosis), cancer or endocrine disorders. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals or physical injury.
- 3.7 No warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied, are made under this contract except as

stated.

3.8 This Health Guarantee is non-transferable.

For the long-term health of your puppy the Breeder recommends a diet containing at least 20% raw meaty bones, minimal exposure to food additives. The Breeder also recommends minimizing exposure to veterinary drugs (such as flea and heartworm treatments, vaccinations, and wormers) to the minimum dosage and frequency needed to safeguard the health of your pet.

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4. Spay and Neuter Contract

4.1 Spaying/neutering by a licensed, reputable veterinarian is required on your puppy no sooner than 12 months but before 14 months of age.

- Proof of this, in the form of a Certificate of Spay/Neuter from the Veterinarian, must be forwarded to the Breeder by the time the puppy reaches 15 months of age.
- If the Breeder does not receive this documentation within this time, the Health Guarantee will become null and void.

4.2 It is understood that at the time of sale that the puppy is not to be used for breeding. It is a representation of its breed and it is structurally and temperamentally suited for a companion and/or working dog. It is being sold as a pet without breeding rights.

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4. Lifetime Rehoming Guarantee

Your puppy also has a lifetime rehoming guarantee with us, so should you have an inability to care for him or her in the future, the buyer agrees to contact the Breeder immediately if the buyer determines they are unable to keep their puppy for any reason and at any stage of your puppy's life. The Buyer also agrees that under no circumstances will they ever place their puppy within a rescue group, a shelter, a pound, or into any other similar facility or research laboratory.

By signing below, the Buyer agrees to the Breeder's terms and conditions regarding the Health Agreement. The Breeder also commits to uphold all responsibilities and guarantees stated within this Agreement, ensuring adherence to the terms set forth for the health and well-being of the puppy. This mutual understanding ensures both parties are accountable and agree to fulfill their respective obligations as outlined.
